

**Report on relief assistance to people affected by the tropical storm Podul  
Relief and Community Health Bureau (RCHB), Thai Red Cross Society  
during 28 August – 1 September 2019 (as of 1 September 2019)**

**1. Situation of the storm Podul**

Department of Disaster Prevention and Mitigation (DDPM) has summarized the situation from 29 August up to 1 September as followed : flash flood and mudslide in 13 provinces which are Chiang Mai, Prae, Petchaboon, Amnat Charoen, Nakorn Phanom, Roi- Et, Ubon Ratchathani, Maha Sarakham, Nong Bua Lam Phu, Pracheenburi, Krabi and Rayong. There are 17 districts, 33 sub-districts, 72 villages (194 households) affected. Current situation in 5 particular provinces:

**Ubon Ratchathani** (Kud Khao Poon district, 65 households affected)

- Water is receding

**Roi-Et** (Salephoom district, Pho-chai district, Moeiwadee district and Muang district, 12 sub-districts, 38 villages)

- Water is receding

**Maha Sarakham** (Muang district)

- Water is receding

**Petchaboon** (Chondaen district)

- Water is receding

**Ranong** (Kraburi district, 64 households affected)

- Water is receding

**2. Relief assistance provided**

RCHB has provided relief assistance during 28 August – 1 September totaling 9,280,000 THB including relief kits and flat boats. TRCS has done the assessment on-site to evaluate the situation and provide urgent needs accordingly:

- Distribution of 9,280 relief kits (totaling 9,280,000 THB) in Phitsanulok, Mukdahan, Khon Kaen, Yasothon and Kalasin
- Provision of 2 flat boats in Mookdaharn
